## President's Ponderings

2014 is our seventh year of operation. We continued to have over 300 guests at the ranch in 2012 and 2013 and held retreats at both the Tierritas and the Espejo camps.

During the Winter 2013 OCM board meeting, the 3 board members decided that it would be in the best interest of OCM if we reduced our time load and a few of the expenses by focusing on operating the Espejo camp and pasture and eliminating the Tierritas pasture. It was clear to us that we could accomplish our mission with the housing and thousands of acres provided at the Espejo. The Espejo pasture and its headquarters include a higher level of housing, a swimming pool, and it is only 6 miles from the paved road as opposed to 16 miles to the Tierritas. The Espejo also has a caretaker that is at the ranch most of the time.

The transition has gone well. John Meyer and Pastor Walker worked closely with us from December 2013 through March 2014 on many details. Clifford, Andy and I moved over 16 pickup loads of tools, furniture and supplies in about 60 days. Volunteers moved 2 game blinds and 2 game feeders in April. Volunteers have conducted 4 retreats in 2014 through May.



Two volunteers, Rick Garza and "Rodeo" Long, have become more of an integral part of our retreats beginning in the early fall of 2013. Rick brings a lot of outdoor experience. Rodeo first attended an OCM retreat about 6 years ago as a teenager. Since that time, Rodeo has graduated college and is a lay preacher. Rick has helped with numerous ranch tasks and Rodeo is providing Bible lessons during retreats.

It is an honor for all of us to serve through the OCM activities.
